Thank you to Dean Opalniuk for donating your \$60 sweeps winnings back to our school.

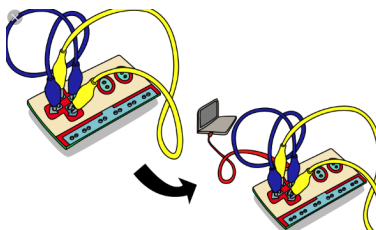


STEM T4L WORKSHOP

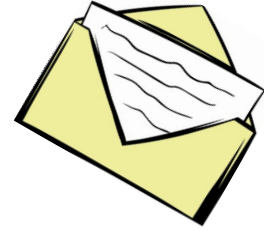
