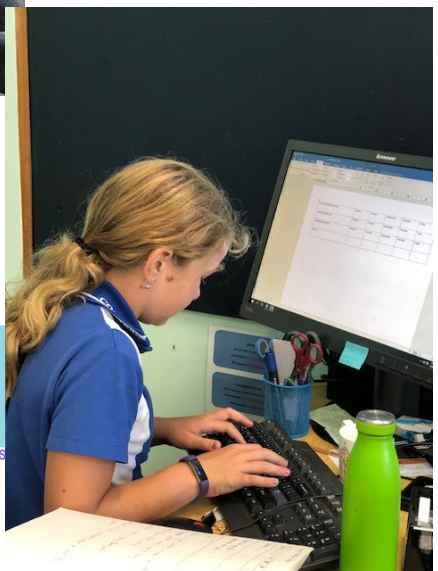






## Cowper Kitchen Garden Project
