

Four of our Year 6 student's artwork will feature in the '2019 The Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange' program!!!

Chloe Jefferies, Mia Wakeford, Reece Ireland and Abi Moran are ecstatic to have created artworks that have been selected to participate in the **'2019 The Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange'**. Their artworks were selected from students' works from across the state.

'The Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange' is an exhibition opportunity open to all NSW public schools students from kindergarten through to Year 12. It is held annually and encourages students to participate in international friendship and cultural exchange activities, which in turn promotes the further development of sister city relationships.

Schools are only able to nominate a maximum of four outstanding K-12 student artworks that would be suitable for consideration for the "Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange". The nominated artworks are viewed by a selection panel for inclusion in the exhibition.

The selected artworks from NSW Public Schools are exhibited in Nagoya, Japan along with works by students in Nagoya, Los Angeles, Mexico City, Reims, Turim and Ninjing.

At the completion of the exhibition our students will receive an exchange of artwork from the exhibition in Nagoya and a certificate celebrating their selection.



Inspiration behind the works of art:

The animal study artwork competed by Chloe and Mia depicts a hybrid creature that displays both human characteristics and mythical qualities.

The 'River to Sea' artworks were created by Reece Ireland and Abi Moran for the River of Learning Art Exhibition and symbolises earth's topography, where the river meets the ocean.
